Excerpts of Statement of the  
NATIONAL WILDLIFE FEDERATION

Submitted to the  
Subcommittee on Public Lands  
and Reserved Water Rights  
of the  
Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committee  
on S. 49, a Bill to Redesignate Public Lands  
in Alaska to Allow Hunting  
April 21, 1983

The Federation finds that the provisions of S. 49 are consistent with these principles (which guided the Federation's policy throughout Congressional consideration of the Alaska National Interest Lands and Conservation Act of 1980 (ANILCA) ), and thus supports passage of S. 49 as introduced.

Some opponents of the bill insist that S. 49 is nothing more than an outright attack on "the integrity of the National Park System." If it were the Federation would be first in line to kill it. However, this is not the purpose of S. 49, nor will it be the effect if it passes. Clearly, the proposal does not threaten the resources which the parks were established to protect. As this Subcommittee is aware, Park Preserves are managed exactly as pure National Parks, except that recreational hunting and trapping are permitted. Thus, S. 49 proposes no diminution of the provisions in ANILCA which protect land resources. Neither will the outstanding wildlife encompassed within the boundaries be threatened. Experience has shown that well-regulated sport hunting does not threaten, and in some instances actually enhances, wildlife populations. Rather than threaten the resources which the units were established to conserve, this legislation will simply allow more recreational users to enjoy the resources in these areas.

In conclusion, the Federation urges enactment of S. 49. The proposal is consistent with sound conservation principles. The proposal will not diminish the outstanding resources in these areas. On the contrary, S 49 will allow more outdoor enthusiasts the opportunity to enjoy them. The Federation will oppose any amendments to S. 49 which would weaken the habitat protection in ANILCA, upon which healthy wildlife populations, and thus sport hunting, depend.

### THE BATTLE LINES ARE DRAWN: ALASKA NATIONAL HUNTING BILL

**I**t's nice to know who your friends are—and who they aren't. For a long time I have said that organizations such as the Sierra Club, the National Audubon Society and the Wilderness Society are closet anti-hunting groups. Well, they have finally come out of the closet.

In the December editorial, I told you about an effort being made to return 12 million acres of Alaska land to hunting status. That land was removed from hunting through the device of the Alaska Lands Act about two years ago. Backers of this heavily preservationist and anti-hunting bill included the Wilderness Society, the National Audubon Society, the Sierra Club, the National Wildlife Federation, the Izaak Walton League, Cleveland Amory's Fund for Animals and Alice Herrington's Friends of Animals.

This group lobbied heavily with what was then a liberal Carter administration and got whatever it wanted. And hunters got the short end of the stick on the Alaska Lands Act because 25 million acres ended up being taken out of hunting. This was land on which the animals had never been threatened by sport hunting. In fact, game management has always been excellent in Alaska and there was no good reason to remove any of the state from hunting. But the preservationists wanted as much land made into parks as they could get. They went for it and got it.

It is hard to visualize just how much land 25 million acres is. It is an area about the size of Louisiana, Virginia or New York. This is the amount of land these groups stopped hunting on just in Alaska. So now many of us want to open up about half of that land again. There is no reason not to. The only people who ever used the land in the first place were hunters and trappers. For example, this year there were only 3,000 people at the visitors center for the Wrangell-St. Elias area. And this combination park and park preserve contains 13 million acres. (Park preserves are open to hunting.)

But on December 2, 1982, the Wilderness Society, the Sierra Club, the National Audubon Society and the National Parks and Conservation Association, under the guise of the Alaska Coalition, saw fit to write to all the members of the United States Congress and urge them not to support the bill to reopen hunting on the 12 million acres in question. This is an outright anti-hunting move, and no amount of nay-saying will change it.

It is important to note that the National Wildlife Federation and Izaak Walton League are not part of this new "coalition."

The letter is a bundle of half-truths and misleading statements. For example, it says, "As you know, sport hunting is not allowed in national parks." Yes, but it is allowed in park preserves, which are run by the National Park Service.

The letter says, "The pending legislation, for which the Alaska senators are seeking your co-sponsorship, would throw out this long history of holding the national parks inviolate." The land in question was open to hunting from the beginning of time and has only been closed two years. So which has the longer history—hunting or parks?

But the best is this sentence: "If Denali, Gates of the Arctic, Wrangell-St. Elias, Katmai and other magnificent national parks are opened to sport hunting, can Yellowstone, Great Smokies, Yosemite, Olympic and others be far behind?" This is so far off the wall as to be laughable if it weren't such a pathetically stupid statement. Much more probable would be for me to say, "If the preservationists can lock up 25 million acres of Alaska, how long will it be before they try to stop hunting in more places, not just Alaska?" We are only asking that 12 million acres be reopened, leaving 13 million still in parks.

And who are these people who seek to control so much land in Alaska? I thought I would at least find out how many of them there are, assuming that every member of these organizations is in favor of the management stand against hunting, which I doubt. Remember, there are about 20 million hunters in the United States. The National Audubon Society has 505,000 members. The Sierra Club has 336,262 members. The National Parks and Conservation Association has 40,000 members. And the Wilderness Society has an estimated 5,000 members. If you put them all together there aren't one million members. So who are they to order us around?

I asked you in December to send in \$1 to help the campaign to return this land to hunting. Please do. At the time I write this, the middle of December, about \$3,000 had come in from OUTDOOR LIFE readers. A lot more is needed. If you can't send a buck, send what you can. Donations have ranged from 35¢ to \$25—and I'm just as proud of that reader who sent the 35¢ as the one who sent \$25. You're probably wondering what I sent or if I sent anything. I did—\$10. And I wrote a little note with it just like I asked you to do saying, "I'm an OUTDOOR LIFE reader." I really am.



## REOPEN ALASKA TO HUNTING

Two identical bills were introduced in the United States Senate and the United States House of Representatives in August 1982 by Alaska Senators Ted Stevens and Frank Murkowski, and Alaska Congressman Don Young. These bills are of vital interest to all sportsmen—whether or not they are fortunate enough to hunt in Alaska.

The bills—S. 2836 and H.R. 6977—would open to hunting nearly 12 million acres of prime federally owned Alaska wilderness which was closed to hunting by Congress in 1980 as part of the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act.

The legislation just introduced deals with the right to hunt, and therein lies its importance. The public lands in question had long supported sport and subsistence hunting. The lands were not closed for reasons of wildlife conservation, or to protect

the habitat (mining, cutting, and drilling are not allowed on these lands), or for any other rational reason. They were closed because anti-hunting sentiment prevailed.

The lands to be opened include almost 7.5 million acres of prime Dall sheep habitat in Gates of the Arctic and Wrangell-Saint Elias Parks. These two areas, plus Katmai, Lake Clark, Denali, Kenai Fjords, Glacier Bay, and Aniakchak—a total of 11,780,000 acres—also provide good hunting for brown/grizzly bears, black bears, moose, caribou, and mountain goats.

Reopening these lands—which means amending the Alaska National Interest Conservation Act—requires an act of Congress. The legislation introduced by Messrs. Stevens, Murkowski, and Young would reclassify these areas from “Parks” to “Park Preserves.” The only distinction is that hunting and trapping are allowed in Park Preserves, not in Parks.

The legislative campaign will begin in earnest in January 1983. This legislation will be the first major national confrontation on the subject of hunting, and it requires your continuing support.

The national lobbying campaign for this vital legislation will be spearheaded by the Wildlife Legislative Fund of America. FIELD & STREAM will keep you updated on developments in this campaign to reopen some of the finest wilderness hunting in the world. For now, you should write your senators and congressman to support S. 2836 and H.R. 6977.

### Hunting in Alaska's Wilds

**ALASKA'S CONGRESSIONAL** delegation is pushing for enactment of legislation that will open up 12 million acres in the rugged remoteness of this spectacular state's national parks to hunting and trapping. At first impression, this is the kind of thing that invokes the indrawn breath of exasperation and displeasure that is standard reaction to any increased killing of wild animals. Closer inspection, however, demonstrates considerable validity to the Alaskans' action.

It is important to note that the change would affect only remote areas which were traditionally hunted until withdrawn by the Carter administration in 1978, and are still being hunted by natives of this wild region for subsistence purposes. The Alaska lands act, which became law in 1980, established more than 43 million acres of new national parks and monuments, 24 million of which were closed to sport hunting. Hunting is not permitted in national parks, but is allowed in park preserves. The legislation introduced by Senators Ted Stevens and Frank Murkowski and Representative Don Young would change the designation of the acreage in question to allow hunting.

**MURKOWSKI, A VIGOROUS,** articulate senator with clear devotion to the special qualities that his state has in abundance, emphasizes that the measure will allow Alaska to manage the wildlife resources there "for the benefit of the species and use by Alaska's hunters." How does it benefit a species to allow it to become possible prey to the hunter's rifle and the trapper's snare?

Well, pro-hunting groups maintain that hunters are active and dependable conservationists who practice their sport in compliance with state regulations and do not impair the wildlife resource. They are not like those dreadful ivory pirates who kill elephants in Africa for outlaw profits. The International Association of Fish and Wildlife Agencies, which is an association of state government wildlife agencies, maintains that hunting is "an absolute necessity for the proper management and well-being of many wildlife populations."

Sportsmen's license fees and excise taxes on sporting equipment provide the financial base for conservation programs, habitat acquisition, research and other wildlife programs throughout the United States — to the tune of \$500 million a year.

**WHAT THIS LEGISLATION** does is to preserve hunting patterns that have been traditional in Alaska. As Congressman Young put it: "We are doing nothing new here, only trying to put back in the rights of people to hunt where they have always."

In a state like Alaska, where it takes an accomplished and dedicated outdoorsman to get out to the hunting grounds, that can hardly be a great transgression. And because the hunting season does not begin until the fall, there will be little conflict between hunters and other recreational users like backpackers who tend to visit the areas in the summer.

This legislation will affect only 35 percent of the current national parklands in Alaska. The remaining 20 million acres will be closed to sport hunting. So this is no carte blanche for men and women with guns and traps. There will still be an outright ban in many sections of the state. And an important way of life that supports realistic conservation in this state will be preserved. That would seem solid reason to look on what the Alaskan delegation is doing with a sympathetic eye.

## Hunting in Alaska

**T**he role of a pristine wilderness in our day would seem to be clear — to serve as a source of spiritual refreshment for people to whom, unlike the indigenous birds and beasts, the wilderness is not home. Why can't the nation's lawmakers accept that uncomplicated evaluation?

The subject is controversial, of course, because some strict naturalists would lock up the woods for all except the hardy backpacker. And it is they who believe outdoors sportsmen should be kept off the premises.

In a sense it's an odd issue because neither the environmentalist nor the sportsman conservationist would tolerate the rape of the forest by a careless developer. A messy oil drilling rig is equally abhorrent to both groups, and they share the common goal of seeing unscarred woods and fields preserved for future generations.

Still, the classic battle is being resumed as Congress considers the Alaska Hunting Bill, a measure intended to soften the blow sustained by hunters, fishermen, and trappers when the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act became law in 1980.

The act designated 25 million acres of Alaska wilderness as "parks," in which hunting, fishing, and trapping are prohibited. The hunting bill changes that to "park preserves," thus allowing the sports.

Strict environmentalists are fighting the change which, in effect, closes the wilderness lands to 73 million Americans who spend \$500 million annually on fishing, hunting, and trapping licenses and excise taxes, money that all goes to federal fish and game funds for management and restocking programs.

And there's the rub. The sportsmen claim to be true conservationists who, although they willingly pay for such programs, have been deprived of their sports by environmentalists who don't provide equivalent direct support for the preservation of species.

Those who say the hunting bill threatens wildlife preservation are wrong. Hunting and fishing is regulated and fish and game are managed through daily limits. If pressures rise, the limits are reduced.

The Wildlife Legislative Federation, based in Columbus, Ohio, leads the campaign for the outdoors sportsmen, trying to build political muscle equal to that which did them in when the 1980 law was passed.

The sportsmen have a very strong case. The environmentalists are presumptuous indeed to lock up a territory the size of Indiana for their own selfish and exceedingly esoteric enjoyment — thereby excluding tens of millions of their countrymen who lay out hard cash to preserve the great outdoors.
